





### Key Vocabulary

<b>Easter</b>	Easter is an important religious celebration for Christians. It is a time to remember Jesus' suffering and His resurrection.
<b>Jesus</b>	Christians believe Jesus is the son of God.
<b>Palm Sunday</b>	The day when Jesus arrived in Jerusalem
<b>Maundy Thursday</b>	When the Last Supper happened.
<b>Last Supper</b>	Jesus shared red wine and bread.
<b>Good Friday</b>	When Jesus died on the cross.
<b>Easter Sunday</b>	When Jesus was resurrected.
<b>12 Disciples</b>	The people who believed and followed Jesus.

This term the children will learn about the Easter story.

### Symbols

<b>Palm Branches</b>		When Jesus entered Jerusalem, crowds of people welcomed Him and waved palm branches as He passed by.
<b>Cross</b>		Jesus was crucified on a cross. Christians believe He rose again after His death and that the cross symbolizes both God's sacrifice and the good news of His victory over death.
