


Different types of line:

Which type of line will best suit what you are are sketching?




Tiger in the Storm:



- A canvas oil painting painted in 1891 by Henri Rousseau
- It is also known as, "Surprised!"
- It is currently in the National Gallery in London
 - Rousseau had never been to a jungle or a rainforest and painted using his imagination.

Henri Rousseau and refining sketching techniques.



Key facts:

- 1. He was born in 1844 and died in 1910.
- 2. He was born in France
- **3.** Henri didn't start painting till he was in his 40's.
- **4.** Pablo Picasso is said to have been a fan of his paintings
- **5.** Henri famously claimed that no one taught him how to paint and that, "he had no teacher other than nature."
- **6.** Rousseau's style was to focus on a specific view such as his favourite part of a city and then to add people into the foreground.
- **7.** He received a lot of criticism from critiques saying his painting style was child-like!
- **8.** A Rousseau painting was used as an inspiration for the 2005 animated film Madagascar
