# School dinners

All children in FS, Year 1 and 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Government scheme called Universal Free School Meals. Children can still choose to bring in their own packed lunch if they prefer. For children in Years 3-6 you may be eligible for Free School Meal if you are in receipt of:

- Income Support
- Jobseekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit
- 'Guarantee' element of State Pension Credit

In order for the office staff to check we just need your National Insurance Number and Date of Birth. If you child is in Yr. 3-6 and would like to pay for a hot school meal then please pay via Parent Pay. Meals cost £2.10 per day.

# Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club continues to grow from strength to strength. If you would like your child to attend, there is no need to book, just come along. It costs only £2, paid via Parent Pay. Children must be dropped off at Reception. Parents are not allowed into the classrooms as this is time when staff are busy having meetings and preparing for the day ahead. We ask that parents ensure that they wait with their child until the door opens at 7:45am.

## After School Club

If you would like to book a place please email: <u>childcare@queensway.oxon.sch.uk</u>. We are also happy for parents to ring and book a place if they need emergency childcare for that day. If we have spaces, we will do our best to accommodate this need.

## <u>Trips</u>

Teachers are busy planning school trips for this academic year. In order to help families budget for trips we put a cap of £30 per child on the total cost of trips for the year. Rarely do we go up to £30. The value of school trips is huge and I urge all parents to budget ahead of time. Parents can pay in instalments via Parent Pay- a £1 per week might be easier than £15 in one go.

## **Volunteers**

Last year we were extremely lucky to have a number of volunteers which made a huge difference to the children meaning that they had some quality 1:1 time reading with an adult. This year we would love to increase the number of volunteer helpers who come into school. Therefore, if you have any spare time to offer, please do speak to me or the class teachers so we can have a chat and arrange appropriate checks. It doesn't just have to be to hear children read.... it maybe to cook with them or help out in an art or PE session.

## Safe parking

As new families start at Queensway I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone about safely parking along Queensway or Brantwood Rise, (not blocking drives or parking up on curbs,) or at the Queensway shops. Our community police team monitor this situation regularly. Remember: it is the safety of your children that is paramount.

## Children walking to school alone

No children are allowed to walk to and from school without an adult. Oxfordshire's Policy is that it is the parent's responsibility to get their child to and from school. Parents are asked to supervise their children until the doors open at 8:30am. Children must be dropped and collected within the school grounds.

## Different people collecting children

In order for us to follow Local Authority Safeguarding regulations please note:

- If you need your child to be collected by someone different than whom normally collects them, then please complete a form with the class teacher or TA during drop off in the morning.
- If you need to change an arrangement during the day then please ring the school office who will provide you with a password to give to the person who you have asked to collect your child. The password must be given to the teacher/TA, by the person collecting, for the child to be released from school.
- We ask that children are collected by people over the age of 16.

## Paperless communitarian

We are going to start the year how we mean to go on and move to a paperless method of communication with parents, so *wherever possible* we will email letters out to parents rather than send home paper copies in book bags. If this poses a problem to anyone then please come and let the office team know. For letters that require signed slips returned to us, such as permission slips for trips and events, this will all be done via Parent Pay where you cannot only pay for tips but also grant permissions for your child.

## Correspondence to separated parents

If your child has parents that live at separate addresses we can email letters to the parent not living with the child for the majority of the week. Please just let the office staff have their full name and email address. The school website should also be a good source of information.

## Clubs for Terms 1 and 2

All clubs start the **week commencing 16<sup>th</sup> September**. We are going to be running a huge variety of clubs and activities for all age groups. If your child would like to attend any clubs please complete the form which your child will be bringing home shortly. Return the slip asap as some clubs have limited spaces. Our experience tells us that the younger children find after school clubs quite tricky as they are often tired. Therefore you will see from the timetable that most KS 1 clubs are at lunchtime instead. Clubs in *italic* have a charge attached to them as they are run by external organisations.

In order to adhere to safeguarding procedures as well as allowing clubs to happen without distraction, parents will no longer be able to wait on the school field with other siblings while a club is in progress, therefore we ask that all families leave the school premises promptly at the end of the school day. If you need to wait on site for a child to finish a club at 4pm then please wait on the grass area outside reception. Thank you for your co-operation.

#### Open days

We are holding a series of Open Days throughout the autumn term for families to come and look round in preparation for choosing a school for their child starting school in September 2020; both nursery and reception. This year we are also hosting a twilight session and Saturday morning session for those families who struggle to make a visit during the working day. Please feel free to pass these dates on to friends who have children of this age and equally if you have younger children starting school next year we hope to see you there too: (Please ring for an appointment)
