Topic

Maths:

We are going to be focusing lots on number and calculation this term. The children will be exploring different addition and subtraction problems and using a variety of equipment to do this.

Literacy:

As mentioned above, our stories will be heavily linked with our journeys topic and we will looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts this term.

PE days

Our regular PE slot has been moved and will now be taking place on a Tuesday morning. All children will need an indoor PE kit of navy shorts and a plain white T-shirt. If the children have pierced ears, please either remove them on PE days or provide surgical tape to cover them.
