
Queensway School- Knowledge Organiser

| Vocabulary- | |
|-------------|--|
| sculpture | Creating figures or designs in 3D form |
| recycle | Recycled Art is creative work that's made from discarded materials that once had another purpose. Artists who make recycled art take those materials and make them into something new. |
| form | Experiment with constructing and joining recycled, natural and manmade materials. |
| shape | Create and arrange shapes appropriately. |
| technique | A way of doing something using special knowledge or skill. |
| materials | The items you use to make the sculpture which can be natural such as wood, stone or paper, or manmade such as metal and plastic. |
| processes | A series of actions or steps taken in order to achieve an end product. |



Materials that can be used for sculpturing:

- paper
- pard
- wood
- cardboard boxes
- art straws
- plastic bottles and lids

Equipment needed to join materials.

- scissors
- glue
- tapes to join and shape
