Year Six Residential

We are delighted to inform you that we will be running a residential trip for the year 6 children next year. The trip will take place from **Wednesday 14th October** until **Friday 16th October 2026** at Condover Hall in Shropshire.

Condover Hall is set in the Shropshire countryside offering a combination of outdoor and indoor adventurous activities. The trip includes dormitory accommodation for two nights and all meals. During the trip, the children will take part in ten 90-minute activities led by a qualified instructor, these may include activities like abseiling, zip wire, fencing, archery, low ropes and much more! The children will receive three meals a day served in a communal dining room and there will be a variety of hot and cold dishes and vegetarian options. Condover Hall will make special arrangements for specific religious and dietary requirements.

The total cost for the trip, including travel, is £341 per child. In order to secure your child's place on this trip, please visit Parent Pay where you need to give your permission and pay a £50 **non-refundable** deposit. The deadline for the deposit and permission is **Friday 26th September. By April 17th, a second deposit of £67 will need to be paid.** This is also not refundable. Condover Hall set guidelines for cancellation dates and refunds. Once you have confirmed your child's place on the trip, you will be able to pay the remainder of the balance (£224) in either stages or as one payment in addition to the deposits. The final payment for the trip will be due on **Wednesday 1st July 2026** If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, is a Service Child or a 'Child We Care for', and you would like to discuss financial support, please come and speak to our School Business Manager, Sonja Smith.

If you require any further information regarding this trip at this stage, please do not hesitate to contact us. Once we have confirmation of the children who are attending the trip, we will communicate more information about what the children need to bring and a timetable of the activities the children will be doing.
