Une table – a table

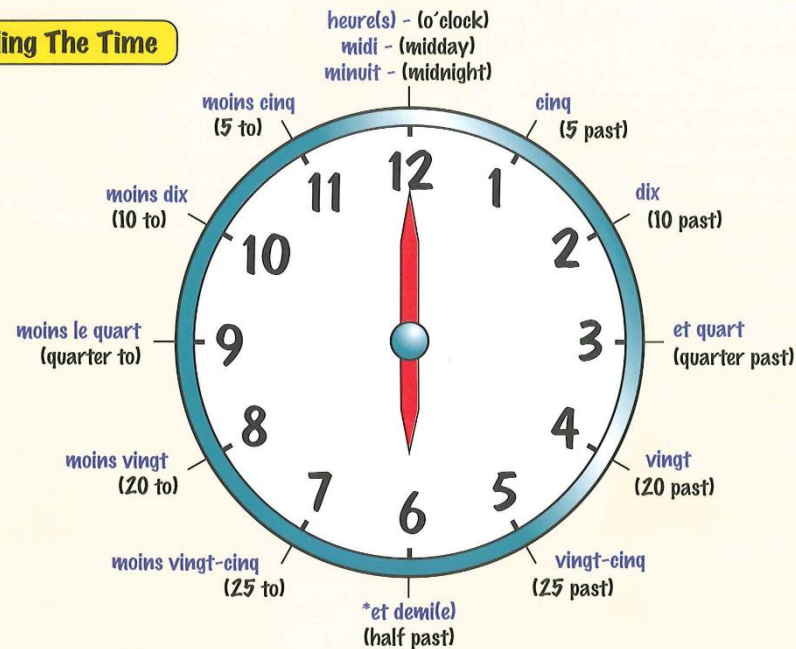
Des chaises – chairs

Telling The Time



Quelle heure est-il? (What time is it?)
Il est 5 heures (it is 5 o'clock)

à quelle heure...? (at what time...?)
Je me lève à huit heures (I get up at 8 o'clock)

* demi needs an 'e' when you are talking about an hour but not with midi or minuit
e.g. une heure et demie - half past one midi et demi - half past twelve



In French, you choose from **un**, **une** and **des**, depending on whether the noun is masculine (male) or feminine (female), and singular or plural. **un** is used in front of masculine nouns, **une** is used in front of feminine nouns and **des** is used in front of plural nouns (more than one).
