



### **Key facts:**

- 1. He was born in 1844 and died in 1910.
- 2. He was born in France
- 3. Henri didn't start painting till he was in his 40's.
- 4. Pablo Picasso is said to have been a fan of his paintings
- **5.** Henri famously claimed that no one taught him how to paint and that, "he had no teacher other than nature."
- 6. Rousseau's style was to focus on a specific view such as his favourite part of a city and then to add people into the foreground.
- 7. He received a lot of criticism from critiques saying his painting style was child-like!
- 8. A Rousseau painting was used as an inspiration for the 2005 animated film Madagascar
