



Striking and Fielding

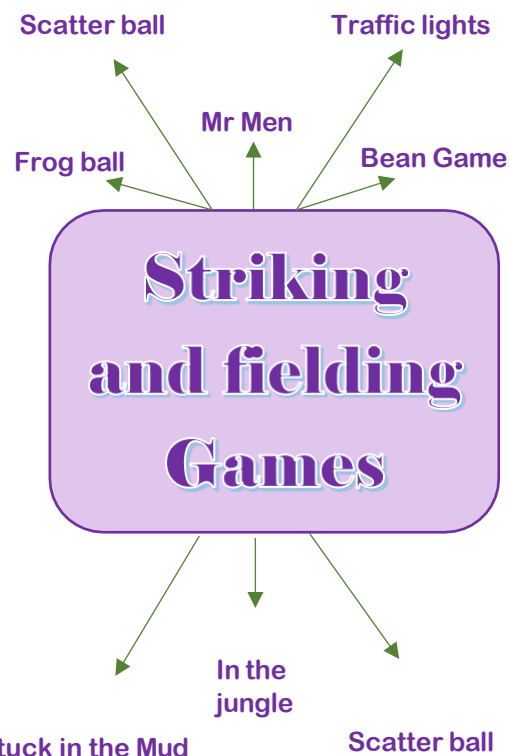

| Striking | The job of the striker is to aim for a target or area. The children will be striking balls with a tennis racket. |
| Fielding | The role of the fielders is to defend an area or to prevent the strikers/batters from scoring against them. The children will be practicing this skill when playing scatter ball. |
| Teamwork | The children will be working as part of a team to attack the other team and score, as well as defend from the other team scoring against them. |
| Communicating | Communication is the key skill we will be working on this term. The children will practice talking to each other while playing. |
