Dear Parents,

Well we have finally welcomed back more children this week- it has been so nice to see them! After lots of planning and preparation the school opened to children in nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 6, along-side Key Workers. We have had approximately 33% attendance of those that were eligible to attend so small groups of 8 or 9 children. The children have been fantastic; no tears coming in and skipping out of school very happy. I hope you all managed to see the videos which the teachers made on Monday; for the year groups who are invited back the video was a tour of the rooms and for the other year groups it was a story. I want to say a big thank you to the parents who have been in this week; following all the new routines and directions and also catching staff to say thank you- this has meant a lot to staff who have been keen to make the start a positive experience for everyone.

Just some quick reminders for children attending school:

- Please ensure they have a named water bottle with them every day.
- Please can parents apply sun cream before coming into school so that staff only have to reapply cream later on in the day for those children who can't do it themselves.
- Please ensure children have a hat.
- The free fruit and milk scheme for the younger children is not operating so please ensure your child has a piece of fruit to have at break time. Children can top up their water bottle throughout the day.
- Families who are eligible for Free School Meals and are therefore receiving the e-vouchers need to bring a packed lunch to school for the child. Please note this is different than previous correspondence.

The staggered start and finish times have worked well preventing large gatherings around the gates and parents have been respectful only bringing 1 adult on site with the child. The times for drop off and collections remain the same all term:

(Children who do 15 hours in nursery: am session will be 9:15-12 or pm 12:15-3pm)


