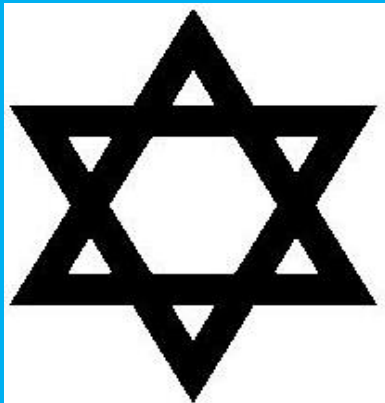




## Synagogue

# Inside the synagogue

## Key vocabulary:

**Worship**- an act different people do to show they are worshipping their god.

**Synagogue**- a place of worship for Jewish people. Jews use synagogues as places to meet, worship and study.

**Torah**- a holy book of Judaism

**Hebrew**- The language the Torah is written in.

**Church**- Is a place where Christians worship.

**Kippah** – a cloth cap worn by Jewish men

## Key facts
