



RE - What it means to be a Christian

This term we will be focusing on Christianity, specifically looking at what it means to be a Christian. Children looked at Jesus' miracles in term 1, so will now develop their understanding further.

Children will be focusing on why Christians look at Jesus as a role model and his importance in their religion. Children will also be researching about life as a Christian and what that involves, including their worship and beliefs.

Key vocabulary:

Jesus	In Christianity, Jesus is believed to be the son of God.
Christians	These are people who follow the religion of Christianity.
Belief	This is when someone accepts that something is true or exists, even without proof.
Faith	This is when someone has complete trust and confidence in something or someone.
Christian worship	This involves praising God, including with music, readings and prayers. Christians often go to Church to carry out their worship, but it can also be done at home.
Church	This is the building used for Christians to worship in.
Role model	This is someone who is looked up to by others.
