

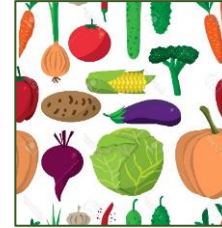


Harvest then and now

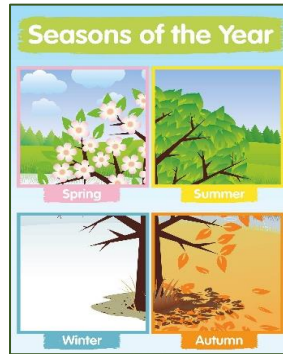
Key Vocabulary:

Harvest	Harvest is a time of year when food is collected.
Crop	Crops are food that are grown on farms, like fruit and vegetables.
Farm	A farm is a place where food is grown and animals are looked after.
Farmer	A farmer is the person who looks after the farm.
Season	Seasons are a time of year. England has 4 seasons, winter, spring, summer and autumn.
Plough	Ploughs are used on farms to turn the soil ready for the seeds.
Combine Harvester	A type of machine used on farms to cut crops. They didn't have them in the past.

Most fruit and vegetables are picked in autumn time. In the months September, October and November.
