Key Vocabulary:

Invasion	Invasion is when a game has someone who is trying to attack their opponent's territory and score a goal or point. Normally you need lots of teamwork in invasion games.
Attacker	The job of the attacker is to score as many points or goals as they can without being stopped by an opponent. Attackers work as a team to plan how they can work together to score.
Defender	The job of the defender is opposite to the attacker. They are working against the attacker to try to stop them scoring any goals or points.
