Key Skills:

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|  <p>Throwing</p> | The children will be practising and revising passing a ball over longer distances. Focusing on the different passes and how to ensure their throw is accurate and controlled. |
|  <p>Catching</p> | The children will be practising their hand eye coordination skills, ensuring they have an effective technique for catching an object accurately. |
|  <p>Travelling</p> | The children will be looking at the different ways they can travel around a space effectively. They will also focus on looking for empty space as well as looking where they are going whilst moving. |
|  <p>Rolling</p> | The children will also be focusing on passing a ball through rolling. They will be practising aiming at the target before sending the ball. |
|  <p>Kicking</p> | The children will be developing their aiming skills by kicking balls at a target accurately. |
|  <p>Striking</p> | The children will also be using a racket to strike a ball towards a target. They will be developing their hand eye coordination further by hitting a ball that is thrown to them. |

Key Vocabulary:

| Invasion | Invasion is when a game has someone who is trying to attack their opponent's territory and score a goal or point. Normally you need lots of teamwork in invasion games. |
| Attacker | The job of the attacker is to score as many points or goals as they can without being stopped by an opponent. Attackers work as a team to plan how they can work together to score. |
| Defender | The job of the defender is opposite to the attacker. They are working against the attacker to try to stop them scoring any goals or points. |
