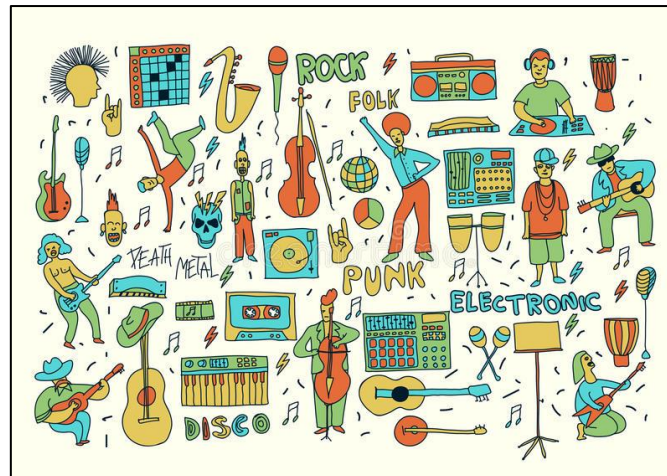




Key Vocabulary	
Rhythm	A rhythm is a strong, regular repeated pattern of movement or sound.
Genre	The genre of music refers to the musical style such as jazz or salsa.
Pitch	The pitch is the quality of a sound governed by the rate of vibrations producing it.
Dynamics	The dynamics refer to the variations in loudness of a musical composition.
Structure	The structure is the order the different parts of the song are played in.
Composition	A composition refers to an original piece of music.
Tempo	The tempo is the rate of speed of a musical piece.
