

Glossary of key words for Terms 3 and 4

Word	Meaning
Digit	Any of the numerals from 0 to 9, especially when forming part of a number.
Integer	A number which is not a fraction; a whole number.
Proportion	A part, share, or number considered in comparative relation to a whole
Ratio	The quantitative relation between two amounts (1:6 for every 1 red cube, there are 6 white cubes)
Increase	Something gets larger
Decrease	Something gets smaller
Product	Multiply (the product of 3 and 4 is 12)
Cube (number)	A number that is the answer to a number times itself 3 times ($3 \times 3 \times 3 = 27$ 27 is a cube number)
Square (number)	A number that is the answer to a number times itself twice ($3 \times 3 = 9$, 9 is a square number)
Prime (number)	A number that is divisible only by itself and 1 (e.g. 2, 3, 5, 7, 11).
Prefix	A word, letter, or number placed before another
Suffix	A morpheme added at the end of a word to form a new word (e.g. <i>-ation</i> , <i>-fy</i> , <i>-ing</i> , <i>-it is</i>)
Antonym	A word opposite in meaning to another (e.g. <i>bad</i> and <i>good</i>).
Synonym	A statement of the exact meaning of a word, especially in a dictionary.
Inference/Infer	Deduce or conclude (something) from evidence and reasoning using own ideas
Revolution	A change
Industry	Activity concerned with the processing of raw materials and manufacture of goods in factories.
Urban	Relating to, or characteristic of a town or city.
Rural	In, relating to, or characteristic of the countryside rather than the tow
Journalist	A person who writes for newspapers, magazines, or news websites or prepares news to be broadcasted
Genre	A style or category of art, music, or writing (text)
