She painted pictures of teddy bears, dolls to still life (A painting/drawing that focuses on still objects) and industrial landscapes (A painting/drawing of natural scenery).

As well as painting pictures Deborah also painted backgrounds for films and plays.

Deborah travelled all over the world, but never married.

She died on Christmas Eve 2012.

Deborah would often paint images of victorian street scenes including different shops such as antique, clothes and toys using oil paints.




Teddy Bears



Deborah would often paint teddy bears wearing different outfits and surrounded by other toys.








